

Minutes GPAMA 19 January 2022

Meeting called to order at 1824 with quorum present (EW PG RY MM). December minutes adopted as distributed. Treasury report indicated \$408.20 in checking, \$5 in savings.

Green Council report and discussion occurred, with reporting of next GC meeting January 30, at 2:00 p. m., by teleconference. Keri Barber resigned her position. **Pete Gleichman was elected new GC representative from GPAMA.**

Old Business.

- 1) Discussion about statewide redistricting occurred with report that Fair Districts New Mexico is following the effort to get a resolution through the legislature to put an Independent Redistricting Committee on the 2022 ballot.
- 2) PG reported on the effort to find an alternative to PayPal (concerns raised about the company excluding Palestinians from using its services) and recommended continuing with PayPal for now as he received no response from various groups supportive of Palestinian rights or found that those groups used PayPal. He will update the group if he learns new information.
- 3) We voted to continue co-sponsoring Gateway Green webinars in 2022. MM will give our two-minute statement on military contamination of water in New Mexico at the webinar on February 2.

New Business.

- 1) MM will send request for general GPAMA meetings notice to be published in the newsletter of the Albuquerque Center for Peace and Justice.
- 2) EW will send a message to GPUS Media Committee asking if they know anything about FreePressMedia which approached GPAMA about a podcast interview.
- 3) We viewed a music video by Mistahi Corkill and agreed to share it on line.
